Intent : That the parties to this agreement, as stated above, agree to enter into a cooperation agreement to generally further their respective International Education programs through specific projects as detailed below:

a) To initiate a practicum teacher program between Lertlah Schools and Buriram Rajabhat University, with cooperative learning opportunities with the practicum students in Thailand annually from the University of Winnipeg, Canada.

b) To develop opportunities between the faculty of the University of Winnipeg and the faculty of Buriram Rajabhat University for cultural and academic exchange programs with Lertlah Schools, Thailand acting as the liaison facilitator.

c) To initiate a cultural exchange opportunity whereby students from both universities are provided with the opportunity to attend, on a short term basis, the universities and to participate in academic, community, and cultural activities.

d) To enter into serious discussions with the objective of developing a dual degree program to interested faculty of education students and/or Master's degree students in the education discipline.

e) To develop opportunities for faculty of all three parties to research and study intercultural academic projects through technological linkage and/or a visiting scholars program.

Term : This agreement will be effective for a period of five years from the date of signing and will be subject to change, renewal or termination by mutual consent.
